As a global leader in habitat, Saint-Gobain is committed to using its expertise to help disadvantaged communities. The international foundation Saint-Gobain Initiatives was established for this purpose.

Initiatives

The Foundation relies on the commitment of Saint-Gobain's employees. All Group employees and retirees are given the opportunity to sponsor charitable initiatives in the three areas that relate to Saint-Gobain's strategy:



helping young adults into employment (p. 05)



building, improving or renovating social housing (p. 09)



reducing energy consumption and protecting the environment around social housing (p. 13)



"These three objectives are at the heart of the business and strategy of our Group, and our aim is to make environmentallyfriendly, energy-efficient and attractive housing accessible to the greatest possible number of people," says Pierre-André de Chalendar, chairman and CEO of Saint-Gobain. "We believe that access to appealing and healthy homes that maximize natural light have a social value. This represents genuine assistance for the most disadvantaged people in our society."


Commitment

Projects must be led by a non-profit organization and located near to one of the Group's sites.

The Foundation provides financial support for the projects it selects. In addition, Saint-Gobain Group companies may supply the materials and/or technical expertise.

In some cases, an opportunity arises for local employees to get involved with the association leading the initiative and participate on a voluntary basis.





Process

Each project is proposed and sponsored by a Saint-Gobain employee or retiree. A presentation package for the project is prepared by the sponsor and then reviewed by the Selection Committee, and if approved, by the Executive Board. These two committees comprise current and retired employees of the Saint-Gobain Group.

The Board of Directors of the Foundation approves general policy and the main areas for action. It is chaired by Pierre-André de Chalendar, and comprises

15 members, including two employee representatives and five experts in the fields of construction, architecture and helping people into employment. Project coordination and monitoring is carried out by the Director of Responsible Development Department.

The Foundation is funded by Compagnie de Saint-Gobain and the Innovative Materials, Construction Products and Building Distribution Sectors. Its budget is EUR 1 million per year.

ith almost 193,000 employees world-wide in 64 countries, located in rapidly-growing regions and developed countries, Saint-Gobain is well aware of the challenges issued by unemployment and aims to help the most disadvantaged to become more employable.

Alongside specialized organizations, the Foundation helps prepare people with little chance of employment for work in housing construction, renovation and refurbishment.
